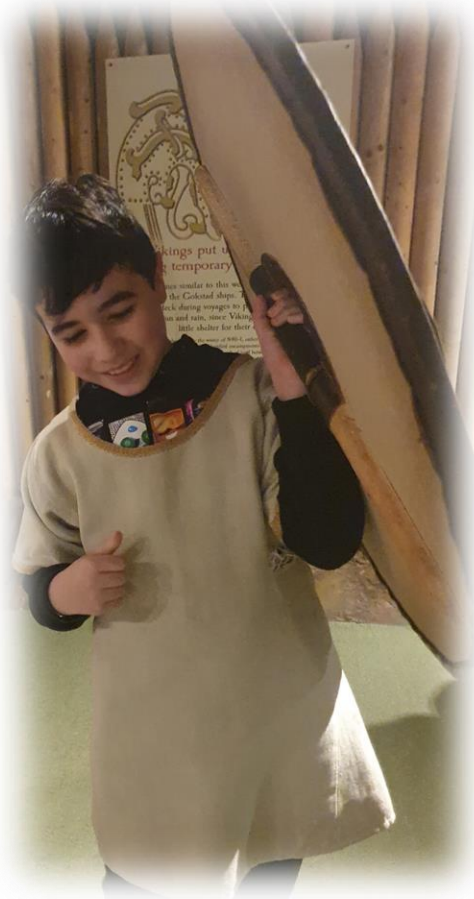


ALC Blue Summer Newsletter 2023

In February, we enjoyed 'Plock', a weird and wonderful Art show in the Project theatre. We had fun making our own splattery Jackson Pollack inspired art.

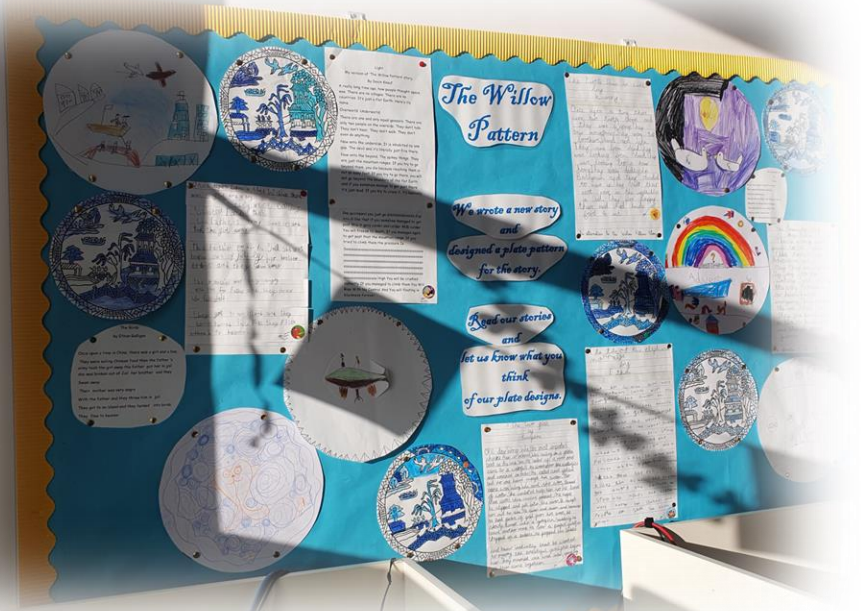


Creative Arts
